



To start here's what you need:

- Used greeting cards (as many as you can find)
- Glue
- Scissors.

Optional:

- Sharpie (Gold)
- "Eid Mubarak" Stamp / Print out
- 1" circle punch
- Dimensional tape (or mounting tape)

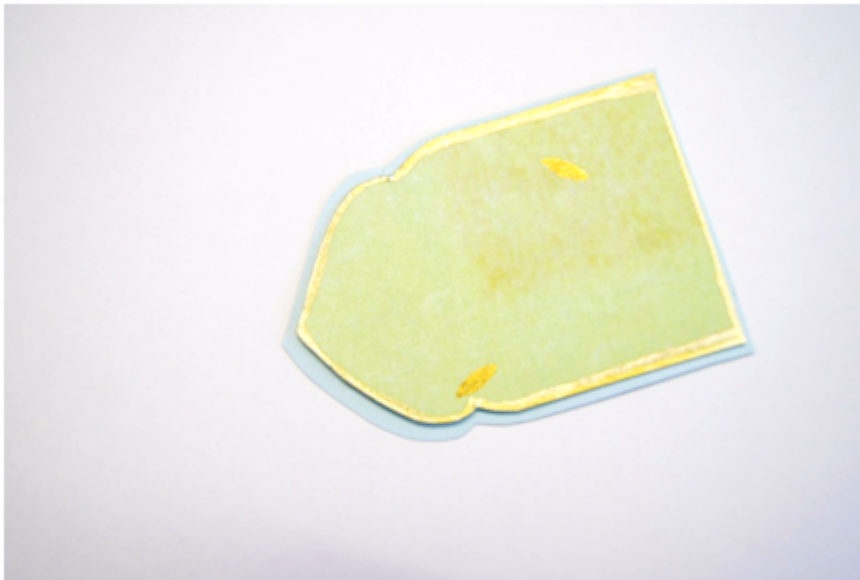
1. Decide on a template you'd like to use for your "mosque". I have a couple cut outs that I keep handy, so it's easy to trace and cut.



2. Once you have a template ready, use a recycled greeting card and trace and cut out the shape. Then I decided to accent the edges with a golden sharpie. (optional)

3. Trace out a slightly larger shape on a corresponding color.

4. Glue them on top of the other like this.



5. Next I used my Eid Mubarak rubber stamp.



If you don't have a stamp, you can print the text using Microsoft Word- English or Arabic

7. Assembling it all together, I thought it looked pretty dull.



8. So I punched out shiny starbursts from another used greeting card. Finally I added dimensionals (aka foam tape) to my masjid, so to give it a 3d look.

And we're done!
